07:30–08:30	Unofficial men's weight
08:15–09:30	Verification for competitions in all weight categories: corrections of entries, verification of start lists, verification and reporting of seedings for competitions
08:30–09:30	Official men's weight – weight categories: 60kg, 66kg, 73kg, 81kg, 90kg, 100kg, +100kg
09:45–10:30	Technical conference and competition draw – all weight categories (women's and men's competitions). Separation of participants in accordance with the PZ Judo Sports Regulations.
10:15	Referee meeting
10:45	Official opening of the competition
11:00	1st round of the competition: elimination fights, repechage fights, and medal fights according to the competition program. Men – weight categories: 60kg, 66kg, 73kg, 81kg, 90kg, 100kg, +100kg. The order in which the weight categories will be announced in a separate announcement.
11:00	Unofficial women's weight
12:00–13:00	Official womans weight – weight categories: 48kg, 52kg, 57kg, 63kg, 70kg, 78kg, +78kg
Okolo 14:30	2nd round of the competition: elimination fights, repechage fights, and medal fights according to the competition program. Woman– weight categories: 48kg, 52kg, 57kg, 63kg, 70kg, 78kg, +78kg The order in which the weight categories will be announced in a separate announcement.
	Medal fights and finals will be held during the competition. Medalists' decoration ceremony during the competition

* ATTENTION! The competition program and schedule for individual weight categories may change depending on the number of registered and verified competitors. The final program for the order in which the weight classes will be held will be announced after the technical conference.

11. Resolution rules:

- a) a) Registered competitors must have an active license from their federation and current sports and medical examinations (medical certificate)
- b) b) Each competitor is obliged to have an Official IJF Backnumber or an Official Backnumber from his federation
- c) Coaches- The rules of the Dress Code and the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches apply.

12. Age of competitors, training level, fight time, competition system:

- a) Years: 2009 and older
- b) Training level: minimum 1 kyu
- c) Fight time: 4 min + GS (unlimited time)
- d) The competition will be held on three 7 x 7 m mats
- e) The competition will be held in accordance with the PZ Judo Sports Regulations

13. Weight categories:

- a) Competition weight categories:
Man: 60kg, 66kg, 73kg, 81kg, 90kg, 100kg, +100kg

Woman: 48kg, 52kg, 57kg, 63kg, 70kg, 78kg, +78kg

14. Applications for the competition (until June 3, 2024 - Monday)

Clubs submit applications at least 5 days before the competition, i.e. until June 3, 2024 (Monday) inclusive. 23:59 only via the electronic system:

Applications submitted in any other way (e-mail, fax, etc.) will not be accepted!

Procedure for making corrections (in terms of changing the weight category or deleting an application):

- a) a) Until June 3, 2024 (Monday) via the reporting system.
- b) 4-7/06/2024 until 18:00 via the reporting system and at the same time information by e-mail to the following address zawody@pzjudo.pl
- c) During verification for the competition - according to the competition program.

Late application - the system accepts applications submitted after the deadline - a regulatory penalty of twice the club's entry fee applies. The penalty must be paid no later than the end of verification (PZ Judo Sports Regulations).

- a) White and blue judogi are required. The first person read puts on white judogi, the second one wears blue judogi.
- b) Judo control is carried out in accordance with the rules of Sokuteiki in SOR
- c) White judogi are required for the decoration ceremony.

21. Other:

Current information about the competition will be published on the PZ Judo news channel, in the Telegram application - PZ Judo Competition.

Basic rules of participation

All competition participants - clubs, coaches, officials and players must accept and respect the rights of PZ Judo representatives, the PZ Judo statute, the PZ Judo Sports Regulations, the IJF refereeing rules and the POLADA Anti-Doping rules, as well as the safety rules set by the competition organizer.
